Patient: Annette Olguin

Condition: Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia (now in remission)

Status Update:

This patient continues to thrive on our program. She has had great energy, doesn't feel sick, and works out now 4-5 times per week walking, and doing other lite workouts at the gym. She still has a mild sinus/upper respiratory issue where she is releasing sputum that is yellow or greenish in color. We believe there is still a chronic viral condition, and that has most likely been the cause of the leukemia.

She was recently released by her oncologist after 4 rounds of chemotherapy. (Original prescription was for 6 rounds). The patient and dr. agreed that after 4 rounds of the chemo that she indeed was in complete remission with no signs of the Lymphocytic Leukemia that was diagnosed in 2014. Her most recent PET scans revealed a normal study without signs of any lesions or tumors noted on the original scans. Her most recent blood work shows no signs of leukemia. There are a few markers of deficiency noted with some of the cells, as these were damaged via the chemotherapy, and the body will need some time to repair and replenish these cells.

Upon review of this case, it appears that the use of the Tafa 400 in IV format immediately following the chemo therapy was a total success, and we will be employing this strategy again in the future. This patient was on a 2-day chemo protocol with Treanda and Rituxin. The first day is a 6-hour drip of chemo, and the second day is a 2-hour drip. We gave her 50 ml of the Tafa400 after each of these applications in an IV format, and in some cases immediately following but no longer than a 2 hour delay. On one occasion the IV of our material was not able to be delivered and she described more side effects from the chemo then in any of the other applications, further suggesting the efficacy of an immediate application of our materials to rejuvenate and cleanse the body following the chemotherapy application.

Her current regimen is now consisting of 2 TBS of Triamino in the am, and 2 TBS of Tafa400, orally, in the evening. She is also using the nebulizer 2 x per day to work on respiratory issues and saturate the body with our materials in a different manner, bypassing the gut.

She continues to eat a very clean, healthy macrobiotic type of diet.

The next step is to re-evaluate the neurotransmitters with our saliva testing. We will also analyze the most recent blood tests and update our functional analysis.

She will also once a week IV treatments for 6 weeks alternating 100 ml of Triamino and Tafa400.

The most recent blood tests and PET CT Scans are shown below.

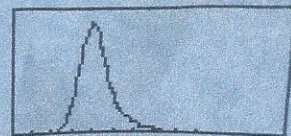
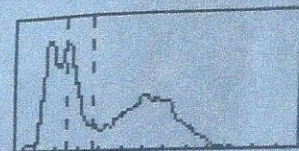

EXAM: PET CT TUMOR IMAGING SKULL BASE TO MID THIGH

CLINICAL INDICATION: 57 years old Female with a history of ovarian mass and chronic lymphocytic leukemia.

PET/CT REQUESTED FOR: Restaging and subsequent treatment strategy.

CORRELATIVE STUDIES: Valley care PET/CT 4/28/2014 showed no evidence of active neoplastic process

TECHNIQUE: Following the intravenous injection of 14.60 mCi right AC 18-fluoro-2-deoxyglucose (FDG), images were obtained from the skull base through the upper thigh on the GE Discovery LS PET/CT whole-body scanner, along with 3D reconstruction. Blood glucose at the time of injection was 107 mg/dL. Oral contrast was given. CT scanning was performed through the same area for the purpose of attenuation correction utilizing a GE LightSpeed Multidetector Scanner.

Total time from injection to start of acquisition was 56 minutes.

The total CT DLP was 1248.30 mGy-cm and the total CTDI was 11.30 mGy. Low dose protocols were performed.

Reference data: Normal liver SUV 3 and right cerebellum SUV 9.8.

FINDINGS: Normal physiologic uptake of FDG tracer is identified within the tonsils, salivary glands, liver, spleen, kidneys, urinary bladder and myocardium.

HEAD/NECK: There are no enlarged or hypermetabolic lymph nodes in the neck.

THORAX:

Lungs: There are no hypermetabolic foci in the lung parenchyma.

Mediastinum: There are no enlarged or hypermetabolic mediastinal or hilar lymph nodes. There is a moderate hiatus hernia.

Chest Wall/Pleura: Negative.

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ABDOMEN/PELVIS: There are no focal hypermetabolic lesions in the liver. The 9 mm anterior left lobe probable liver cyst is unchanged. The gallbladder and biliary tree appear normal. There are no worrisome lesions in the adrenal glands, kidneys, pancreas, or spleen. The abdominal aorta is normal in size. There are no enlarged or hypermetabolic retroperitoneal, pelvic, or inguinal lymph nodes. Bowel loops are normal in caliber with mild physiologic activity. Gynecologic structures are surgically absent. There is no evidence of adnexal cyst or mass. The bladder has a smooth contour.

BONES/BONE MARROW: There are no hypermetabolic foci in the skeleton.

IMPRESSION: Negative stable PET/CT.

Annette Olguin Martin: 57 year old Female.

April 2013.

I was diagnosed with Chronic Lymphocytic Leukemia. I was devastated. So many things went through my mind the day I got the news. My special needs daughter, who would take care of her? My children, would I get to see them in their weddings? My first grandson, will I be too weak to make more memories or just become a short memory of his life? I eat organically everyday, take my vitamins, and exercise, how can this happen to me? I am too young to die!! ! On the way to work one day, I cried and cried and asked God not to let me die. As I went into work that day covering an early shift for an employee, I only had one customer in the store and it was John Everding. I had known him as a customer for approximately 8 years or so but never had been able to engage in conversation as to what he did for a living until that day. After mentioning what he was working on and what he does I started to cry and asked if he could help me! He gave me his business card and told me to email him right away. After emailing him, immediately Dr. Randall Davis was in contact with me and immediately had me do a complete questionnaire and blood saliva test. "I was a candidate", the happiest day of my life after hearing those words. !! Before treatment started my WBC count was at an all time high of 148,000. My oncologist wanted me to start Chemotherapy immediately and scheduled me 1 week later to begin a 6 session regimen. I talked to my oncologist about the Luminec Protocol and if she could please talk to the doctor I am working with before i start any Chemotherapy sessions. Her response was what you can say, very traditional modern medicine belief, "I don't want it to interfere with my chemotherapy protocol". I could feel the negative thoughts and disbelief of my decision but asked her anyways to please talk to him or I wouldn't start the Chemotherapy. Finally she spoke with Dr. Davis and agreed to allow me to do the chemotherapy along side the Luminec protocols. !! I started the Luminec protocol laid out for me 3 weeks prior to my first session of chemo. I had a routine protocol before and after chemo and in between treatments. My chemo was a mixture of Rituxan and Treanda and scheduled for every 28 days, 2 days a week, 6 hours and 2 hours each. My Luminec protocol was a mixture of Tafa and Tri-Amino orally and intravenously, through a nebulizer and a customized nutrition program. I was also on

a protocol through Sabre Sciences products that Luminec started me on in conjunction with their protocol. This protocol and mixture was to help my immune system during chemo. I was fortunate enough to have someone in the family to administer the IV before and after chemo. !! February 17, 2016, It was my first day of chemo and I was terrified, nervous and sick to my stomach knowing the type of toxins I was about to let enter my body. The only thing that got me through that first session was my determination of beating this cancer and my strong feeling and belief that the Luminec protocol will potentially enhance the effects of chemo while protecting me from many of the horrible side effects associated with chemo. After the first round of treatment, I went home and felt absolutely horrible. I was very nauseous and fatigued. I supplemented the Zofran they prescribed me with Cannabis Oil and Acupuncture sessions between chemo rounds. By my fourth round, the nausea and fatigue was essentially non existent and I wanted to go about my day as a normal person but understood I couldn't because my immune system was still compromised internally due to the chemo even though I felt great. !! Results from my first chemo was something no one had ever seen before in the Oncology Office. After only 1 round of chemo and my Luminec protocol my WBC went from 148,000 to 8.7! I was in normal range after only one round! I was lost for words. My oncologist came in and stated my results were remarkable and just kept shaking her head in shock of the results and stated she was expecting numbers in the 40-50 thousand range. !! After the third round, my WBC went down to 2.6 and this made my oncologist nervous and wanted me get a Nulasta shot. I heard so many negative reports on this shot and after several hours of research I told my oncologist I wanted to refuse it because of my firm belief in the Luminec protocol and how it will protect me even with the low WBC count. My oncologist began to explain to me all the possible effects with my immune system being so low and if it became compromised that I could experience high fever, chills, and possible organ failure and that she would give me a different shot that had lesser degree of the same side effects of Nulasta. That scared the hell out of me and I agreed to get the shot. That was the worst decision I ever made. Immediately the next day I felt like I developed severe osteoporosis overnight. I spoke to Dr. Randall Davis about it and he prescribed me to do an extra IV of the protocol and immediately after, I felt like a new person. The pain in my hips and bones were gone. My WBC continued to go down and I agreed to 1 more shot knowing I had the Luminec at home to help me rid the side effects of the shot. !!

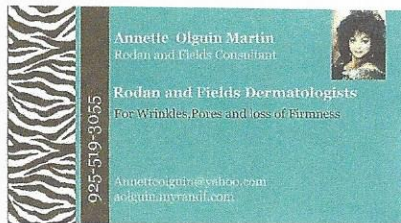
Throughout my chemo rounds despite the beginning side effects and the reaction to the shots, after my Luminec IV after treatment I felt terrific. I felt I could go about my day as if I didn't just have chemo. My family and friends would get upset with me and tell me I needed to rest and stay away from the public. I understood what they were saying but my body and mentality didn't match how I was supposed to be feeling. I was in great spirits and many times people didn't believe me I was in the middle of chemo because I didn't look like the textbook person who is receiving treatment. I wasn't pale from low oxygen due to chemo killing the good RBC's, I never lost any hair and had a lot of energy. !! After four rounds of chemo my blood work showed normal results still and the discussion of 2 more rounds began. My oncologist broke down the positive and negative of stopping the treatments after 4 rounds and told me to go home and think about it. After long thought and debate I chose not to continue the extra 2 rounds of chemo. On my next appointment i discussed with my Oncologist that I did not want to continue with chemo and then I had my blood drawn and was told to come back in 1 week. June 16, 2016

I went back for the results and was given the happiest news in my life, I was officially in remission! Again, my Oncologist was in complete awe of my results and how well I took the treatment. During this appointment she stated to me that my results were remarkable and that she had never let anyone use alternative treatment before under her direct care during a chemotherapy treatment. She also stated that she owed Dr. Randall Davis an apology for being a little rude to him when this all started. !! I am truly grateful to Dr. Randall Davis and John Everding for truly saving my life. I am a true living testimonial, you CAN heal yourself from cancer!! I love you both! Thank you! !
